Because universal fit lift truck buckets slip onto the forks directly, they stay on the machinery and are much less vulnerable to destruction. These buckets are even fifty percent deeper compared to the quick-tach bucket models. This additional space makes them ideal for lifting irregular shaped loads like for instance elevating roof gravel, moving large debris piles, broken up concrete, backfilling behind walls and tearing off roof trash.
